May 27, 2025 Austin County Commissioners Court met in the 2nd floor Courtroom at the Austin County Courthouse with the following present:

Marc Young requested the court reconsider denial of drainage for BESS Facility. Marc provided a handout of facts on government codes for denying permits. He believes the county has a low chance of winning a lawsuit for BESS.

Jonathan Hopko (County Engineer) requests the court extend the bid due date on behalf of the bidders due to the holiday.

The court agrees to extend the due date but advised they must be on a pre bid list for their bid to be accepted on the new due date.

New due date will be June 6 and bids will open June 9 in court at 9am.

They received a bid for the 32 patrol laptops for \$130,769.92 and the 4 constable laptops for \$16,346.24. Total of 36 laptops will be ordered. The Sheriff Office is working with the laptop company to ensure they can use SB 22 funds.

Judge Lapham advised the deadline to have the new laptops CJIS compatible is October 16-19.

Lt. Donald Durracq (Sheriff Office) advised with the lead time given they would need to order the laptops now. The company would accept a purchase order as our form of payment.
