A tax rate of \$0.52000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Austin County.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.52000 per \$100 NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$0.49141 per \$100 VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.57750 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Austin County from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Austin County may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Austin County is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 9, 2024 AT 9:00 AM AT Austin County Courthouse, Second Floor Courtroom, One East Main.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Austin County is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Austin County of Austin County at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

No-New-Revenue Maintenance and Operations Rate Adjustments

Indigent Defense Compensation Expenditures

The Austin County spent \$143,605 from July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 to provide appointed counsel for indigent individuals in criminal or civil proceedings in accordance with the schedule of fees adopted under Article 26.05, Code of Criminal Procedure and to fund the operations of a public defender's office under Article 26.044, Code of Criminal Procedure, less the amount of any state grants received. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's indigent defense compensation expenditures is \$12,176. This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by \$0.00013/\$100.
