Pursuant to Section 127.201(a) of the Texas Election Code (the "Code"), the general custodian of election records in an election in which an electronic voting system is used must conduct a partial manual count. The partial manual count requirement is not waived for the March 3, 2020 Primary Election.

The partial manual count applies to Election Day ballots, early voting in-person ballots, and early voting by-mail ballots.

The partial manual count is required for all counties that automatically tabulate their ballots using an optical/digital scanner. Optical/digital scanners are either precinct ballot counters or central scanners. Therefore, entities that hand counted their ballots are not required to conduct the partial manual count which does include Fayette County Texas.

The partial manual count for the Democratic and Republican Primary Election will be conducted on Tuesday, March 17, at 9am in the Fayette County Elections Office.
