# Filing in the 2022 Republican or Democratic Primary Election

NOTE: Please note that information on this page is subject to change as a result of legislation or court order

Candidates seeking the nomination of the Democratic or Republican

Party must file (1) a candidate application, and (2) a filing fee or petition in lieu of filing fee. Please note, the application along with the filing fee or petition in lieu of filling fee must be filed at the same time with the proper filing authority.

#### Filing Period

The application must be filed between November 13, 2021 and 6:00 p.m. on December 13, 2021. (Section 172.023, Texas Election Code).

### Candidate Application

- In order to become the Republican or Democratic Party nominee for a particular office, you must file an <u>application (PDF)</u> for a place on the ballot with the county or state party chair, as appropriate (see chart). (Section 172.022, Texas Election Code).
- Candidates for federal office must file a <u>federal application (PDF)</u>.

## Filing Fee or Petition in Lieu of Filing Fee

- The application for a place on the primary ballot must be accompanied by either a filing fee or a <u>petition in lieu of filing fee (PDF)</u> signed by a certain number of qualified voters.

#### Judicial Candidate Petitions

- Certain judicial candidates in Bexar, Dallas, Harris, Tarrant and Travis must file <u>additional</u> <u>petitions (PDF)</u>.
- Certain statewide judicial candidates must also file additional petitions using the <u>Statewide</u> <u>Judicial Office on Primary Ballot petition form (PDF)</u>
