**CITY OF CARMINE, TEXAS  
ORDINANCE #76-2023**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARMINE, TEXAS CALLING AN ELECTION FOR MAY 6, 2023, TO ELECT THREE COUNCIL MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING AND FOR NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE ELECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Carmine, Texas (the "City") hereby finds and determines that an election should be conducted in the City for the purpose of electing three City Council Members.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARMINE, TEXAS THAT:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor of the City of Carmine, with the concurrence of the City Council, orders an election to be held on May 6, 2023, for the purpose of electing a three City Council Members, Position 1, Position 3 and Position 5.

**Section 2.** The polling place in the City of Carmine for this election shall be held at the Carmine City Hall Building located at 260 Luther Lane, Carmine, Texas.

**Section 3.** The polling place on Election Day shall be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

**Section 4.** The City Secretary of the City of Carmine, Texas shall act as Officer of the election and by written order of the city council shall appoint a presiding election judge, who will upon acceptance of appointment, appoint an alternate judge, and up to but no more than two (2) clerks. This appointment will be for a single election and he/she shall be given written notice of appointment within 20 days after the appointment. The judges and clerks shall be compensated at a rate of nine dollars (\$9.00) per hour. The presiding judge shall also be compensated twenty five dollars (\$25.00) provided he/she returns unused ballots, election supplies, and sealed ballot boxes to the Carmine Municipal Building (City Hall) when he/she makes delivery of the returns of the election.

**Section 5.** The Central Counting Station shall be the Carmine Municipal Building (City Hall) and that the following slate of officials and other designated persons are hereby authorized to be present and to observe the election counting process:

1. The Mayor and members of the City Council of the City of Carmine, Texas.
2. The Secretary of State and/or his authorized representative.
3. Candidates for City Council.
4. The City of Carmine Secretary.

**Section 6.** The following persons are hereby authorized and approved as persons employed and designated to handle the ballots, count the ballots and be present in the Central Counting Station:

1. The Presiding Judge

2. The Alternate Judge and Clerks to be named by Presiding Judge.
3. The Election Officer.
4. The Assistant Election Clerk

**Section 7.** All resident, qualified voters of the City of Carmine shall be permitted to vote for one of the three council member positions.

**Section 8.** The City Secretary shall receive applications by mail for a ballot to be voted by mail until the close of business on May 3, 2023. Requests for applications should be mailed to:

**Section 9.** The dates and times for early voting by personal appearance shall be as follows at the following location:


Extended hours of early voting in person:

April 24, 2023 and May 2, 2023 – 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM

**Section 10.** The notice of the election shall be given as provided by law.

**Section 11.** Voting at the election, including early voting, shall be by the use of paper ballots and/or optical scan ballots in conducting said election, and that said ballots shall be prepared in conformity with the Texas Election Code, as amended, which have been duly approved by the Secretary of State. In compliance with the Texas Election Code, the City Secretary shall provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling place.


