RE:	Partial Manual Count after the March 1, 2022 Joint Primary Election

Pursuant to Section 127.201(a) of the Texas Election Code (the "Code"), the general custodian of election records in an election in which an electronic voting system is used <u>must conduct a partial manual count</u>.

The partial manual count applies to election day ballots, early voting in-person ballots, and early voting by-mail ballots.

The partial manual count is required for all counties that automatically tabulate their ballots using an optical/digital scanner (DS 450). In Fayette County, the DS 450 is an optical/digital scanner used in the Central Counting Station to scan and tabulate paper ballots.

The race identified for the partial manual count is the Comptroller of Public Accounts. The precincts identified for the partial manual count are:

- 101N La Grange
- 112 Plum
- 423 Holman

The partial manual count will be conducted on Tuesday, March 8, 2022 at 9:00 am at the Fayette County Elections Office, 275 Ellinger Road, La Grange, Texas.
