

# Vaccine Update 4/29/2021

Vaccines are readily available throughout the county. Our dedicated healthcare workers and community volunteers are to be commended on their continuing commitment to provide rapid and convenient options for Fayette County residents.

To date: 13, 802 doses have been administered to Fayette County residents. 8433 residents have received at least one dose, and at least 6,496 residents are fully vaccinated. The majority of vaccines have gone to patients age 65+

- Schulenburg Apothecary has both Johnson and Johnson and Moderna vaccines and is taking walk-in patients when possible. Call 979-743-3265 for more information or to be placed on the waiting list.
