




**Storms:** Please continue to keep an eye on the two gulf systems; Marco is the first, is less dangerous, and is more likely to come our way. Laura will be the second to make landfall, has higher winds, and is less likely to come our way, but the models do not yet agree on where it will go. One track is directly over our area.

**COVID-19 Update:** The turnout, and the final results were much better than expected. Many residents received their results in 36 hours or less. One particularly positive note is that our assisted living centers were tested on Thursday (if the individual staff/residents chose to participate), and there were "0" positive cases for the entire day.

My family of 5, including a toddler was tested and we all received out negative results in rapid fashion.

Our overall positivity rate was an extremely low 2.74% which is a fraction of the average for the state at the moment. Of 656 tested, only 18 were positive. 9 Samples were advised to re-test due to poor samples. The age range was from infant to 80+.
